WEEKLY REFLECTIONS ON THE READING

Our security lies in God alone; he is our anchor and strength. In the Gospel today, Jesus paints a picture of a time when there will be wars and earthquakes and famine. Yet he offers hope and says, *Do not be terrified*. We must know that our security cannot rest in anything of this world, but on God alone, who will sustain us in times of suffering.

In the first reading, Malachi proclaims the coming judgment where the proud and evildoers will face destruction, while those who fear the Lord will be healed.

In the second reading, Paul reminds believers to behave in an orderly way. In the Gospel, Jesus describes events that involve the persecution and suffering of believers, and warns them not to be taken in by false prophets or worldly signs.

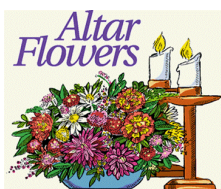

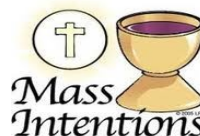
